Part 5 of Mystery Quilt - May 2014

1. You will be assembling a lot of pairs from combinations of 2 blocks:

The Fabric D (striped) block with corners attached and the Fabric C (plaid) with corners at opposite corners.



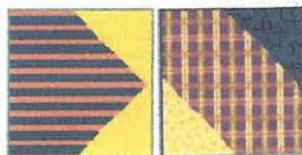

You will sew these two blocks together in two different orientations:



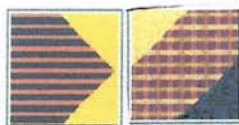
C Block

Orientation A:



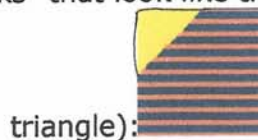
Make 12 pairs in the Orientation A.

Orientation B:



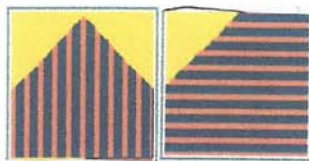
Make 16 pairs in Orientation B.

Now take the 4 "Corner Blocks" that look like this (and have only one corner



triangle):

And sew FOUR pairs with the Fabric D blocks used above in this
Orientation C:

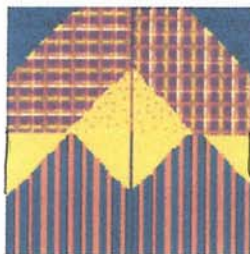


2. Put these 4 corner Blocks back into a baggie labeled CORNER BLOCKS

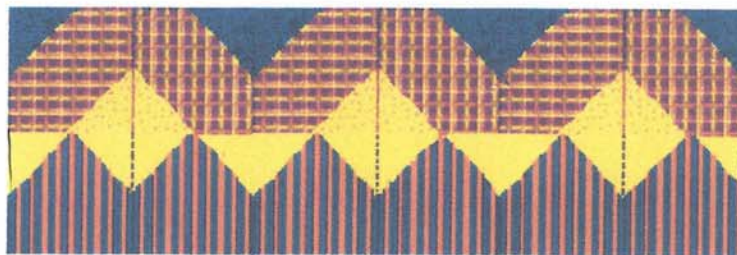

3. Combining 3 pairs each of
Orientation A and B pairs from #1 above:

Pull out 3 each of Orientation A and Orientation B block pairs from #1 above.
Sew first into pairs of 1 A + 1 B so that they look like this:



You will now have 3 of the above A + B combinations.
Combine these 3 into a strip that looks like this:



Make three more of these
so you will have a **total of 4 strips** looking like the above in orientation.

MOSAIC BLOCK #5
12" Finished

We hope you will enjoy doing this block as it is the easiest one in the group of blocks to assemble, but remember when doing it, it is important to press after each step and use scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. **BRING FINISHED BLOCK TO JULY MEETING SINCE THE JUNE MEETING WILL BE OUR RELAY FOR LIFE AUCTION AND FABRIC SALE.**

Light Fabric: Cut

8 4" Squares cut diagonally in half.

Medium Fabric: Cut

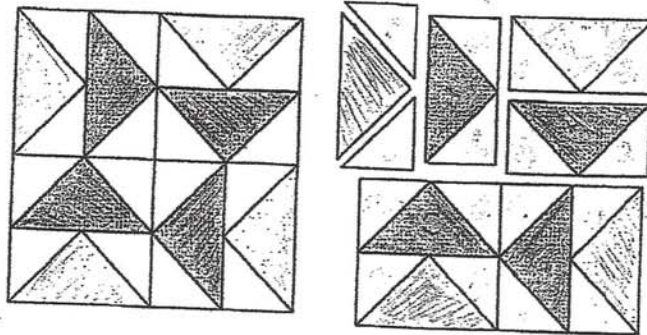
1 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Square cut diagonally twice.

Dark Fabric: Cut

1 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Square cut diagonally twice.

Step 1 Sew the Light triangles to either side of the Medium and Dark triangles. Square up to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Step 2 Arrange the "flying geese" like the diagram below and assemble. Square to 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

You will get to see part of the quilt put together right away and you will even be able to chose fabrics and arrange them to please you. There will be some whimsy to the second part of the pattern. When staring the first part of the pattern take your time cut and layout each piece as you go along, we found it was easy this way and you can see how your colors will look together.

Mystery Quilt 2014

Pattern for a 45" x 38" Pieced and appliqued quilt

- Blue: navy medium to dark shades, can use scraps
M Blue print 1: 3/4 yd.
M Blue print 2: 1/3 yd.
M Blue print 3: 1/4 yd.
M Blue print 4: 1/4 yd.
M Blue print 5: 1/4 yd.
M Blue print 6: 1/4 yd.
- Green: can use scraps
L Green print 1: 1/4 yd.
M Green print 2: 1/3 yd.
L Green print 3: 1/4 yd.
L Green print 4: 1/4 yd.
M Green print 5: 1/3 yd.
L Green print 6: 1/3 yd.
M Green print 7: 1/3 yd.
- Gold: Medium to bright shades, can use scraps
Gold print: 1: 1/4 yd.
Gold print: 2: 10"x10"
Gold print: 3: 10"x10"
- Brown: medium shades, can use scraps
M Brown print: 1: 1/8 yd.
M Brown print: 2: 1/4 yd.
M Brown print: 3: 9"x 5"
- Tan: cream tan prints, can use scraps
Tan prints: 1: 5"x10"
Tan prints: 2: 8"x10"
- Plum: plum to purple shades, can use scraps
D Plum print 1: 1/4 yd.
M Plum print 2: 1/4 yd.
- Cream: can use scraps
M Cream print 1: 1/4 yd.
M Cream print 2: 1/4 yd.
M Cream print 3: 1/4 yd.
L Cream print 4: 1/4 yd.
L Cream print 5: 1/3 yd.
- Salmon: pinkish salmon shades would be good, can use scraps
L Salmon print: 1: 1/4 yd.
M Salmon print: 2: 1/4 yd.
- Red: medium shades, can be used, up to 6 different scrap pieces or 1/4 yd.
M Red print: 1: 1/4 yd.
M Red print: 2: 8"x 8"
- Tan print: 10"x10"
Gold polka dot: 1/4 yd.
Backing 1 1/2 yd.s

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

You need an area 50" by 50" to lay out all the pieces as you cut them (floors and bed works great). The cutting list and layout diagram will help keep things organized while you cut. It works best to lay out the pieces as you cut them.

Background Cutting Instruction

Using your fabric list following the numbers 1-7 depending on the color, you will find the same number on the **Table 1- Cutting List** for each fabric color on this list for the background. The cutting size is listed next to the color and next to that is the position each piece will lay on the quilt.

Half-square triangle instruction

Now we will make half-square triangles (position 5) on quilt layout for the background .

cut the half-square triangles

1. cut 10 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" . Use several navy prints
2. cut 10 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" . Use several red prints
3. place 1 blue square and 1 red square right sides together
4. draw a line from corner to corner to make a half square triangle
5. sew 1/4" along each side of the line repeat for all 10 sets
6. cut along the line to finish making 20 completed half square triangles.

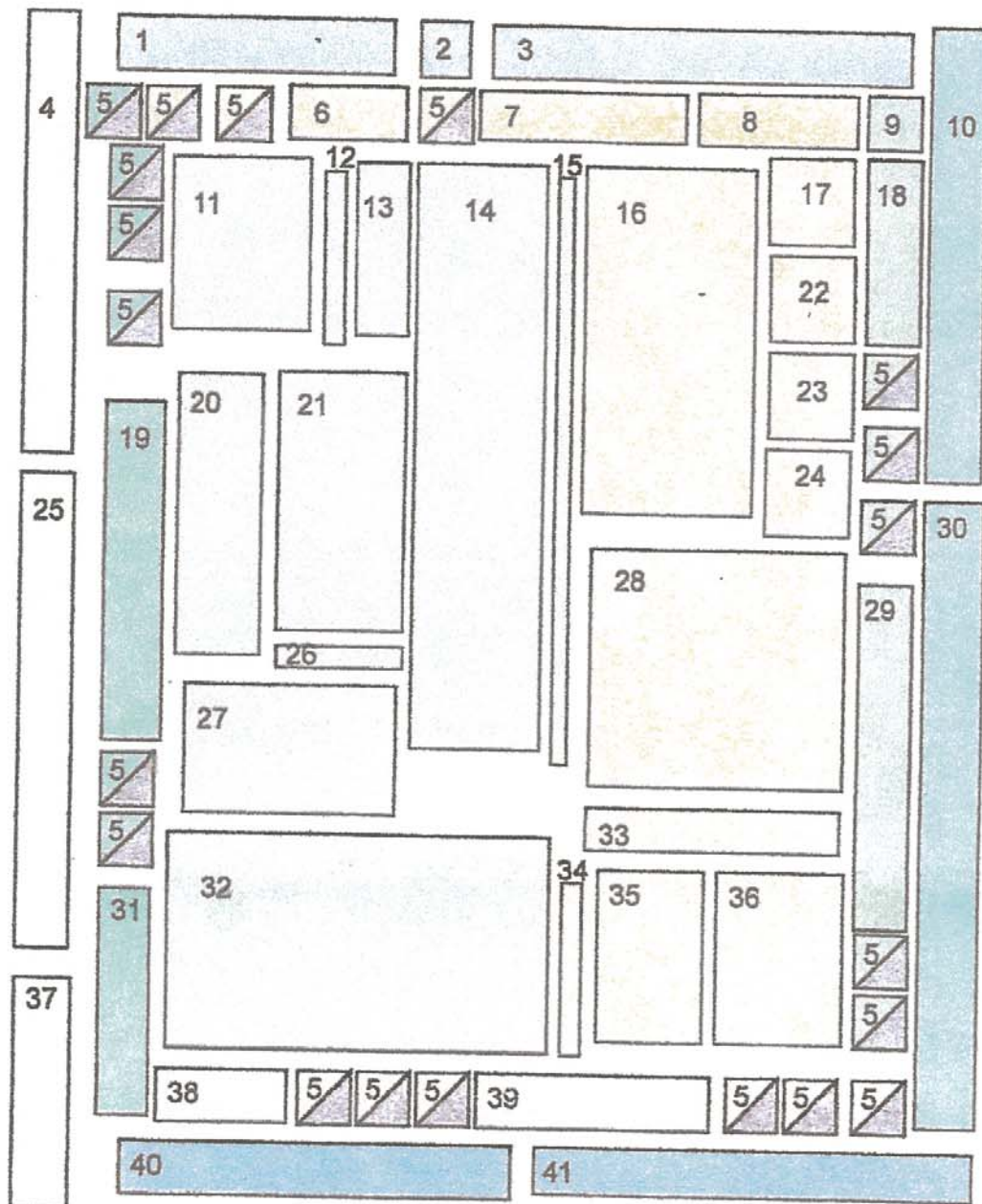

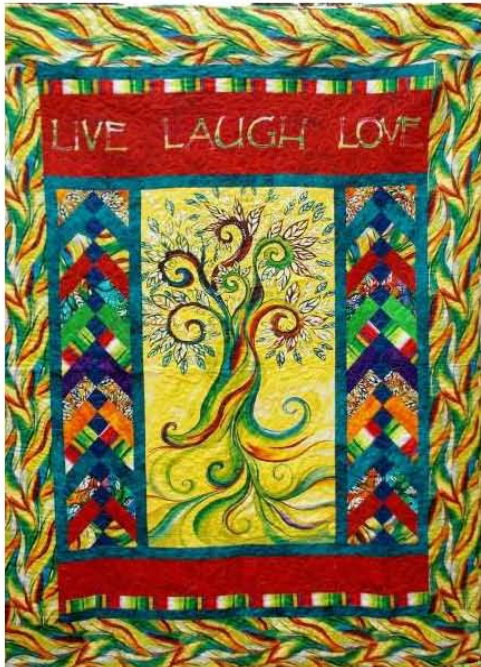
